2024 Chilliwack Pro-Life Scholarship

This Pro-Life Scholarship was established by the Chilliwack Pro-Life Society in 2020 in recognition of the value of youth as future leaders.

Purpose:

- To encourage youth and young adults to learn more about the pro-life movement.
- To encourage youth and young adults to participate in voluntary activities in their school, church and/or community.
- To encourage youth and young adults to be agents of positive change in our society.

Value:

- 1 Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500) to be awarded to a Grade 12 student.
- 1 Fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500) to be awarded to a first-year university student. *In order to receive funds, winning students must provide proof of post-secondary registration.*

Submission must include:

- Completed Application form
- Original essay: minimum 500 words typed, with the title, name of the student and school on the title page. It must be well organized and demonstrate clarity and sensitivity.

Eligibility:

The entrant must be a student in his/her graduating year at a high school, homeschool or first-year of college/university. The student's primary residence must be in Chilliwack, Agassiz, Harrison Hot Springs, or Hope.

Administration of the Scholarship:

- A committee selected by the board of Chilliwack Pro-life will constitute the panel of judges and administer the contest.
- Entries will be judged between May 10 -May 24, 2024.
- Certificate of recognition will be presented to the Grade 12 winner at their graduation ceremony in June, or alternative arrangements may be made.
- Certificate of recognition will be provided to the first year university winner in June.
- Payment will be given to the student once proof of post-secondary registration for 2024/2025 academic year has been provided.

Rights to Work Submitted:

Chilliwack Pro-Life retains the copyright to any work submitted for the contest and the right to publish it for non-profit purposes. The author will be acknowledged in any publication or other use of the essay.

Please note that prize winners will be required to provide a photo of themselves which may be used in Chilliwack Pro-Life publications.

Please choose **one** of the following topics for your essay:

1. **Cultural Change** - After decades of cultural indoctrination, a woman's right to choose abortion has been given priority over the rights of the unborn child. What are some practical ways that the pro-life movement could promote cultural change in the opposite direction; ways to enhance

- the humanity, value, and beauty of the preborn child in the eyes of the average Canadian woman?
- 2. **Responding to "Pro-choice" Dogma** Draft a pro-life response to the saying: "My body, my choice."
- 3. **Facing Discrimination** "Our lives begin to end the day we become silent about things that matter." Martin Luther King Jr. How can pro-life students promote truth about preborn children while at the same time preparing for, and responding to, discrimination for their pro-life views in an academic setting?
